Feasibility Helps with SLR strategy go/no go decision 1. Search Search relevant scientific databases using appropriate search criteria and terminology 2. Exclude Identify exclusion criteria 3. Screen 1 Exclude non-relevant articles by title and abstract Exclude remaining non-relevant articles 4. Screen 2 following review of full text article 5. Write Review and write-up of relevant articles Integrate with the Submit the TGA TGA application application
